CALL TO ORDER: 5:27 PM

Anne Names:

- Announced a new code enforcement officer for Erwin and Painted Post: Rick Miller. She provided a brief update about local addresses they're working on.
- *Benchmarking data:* the bills may be a challenge to wrangle and we have 13-14, though the last two years would be fairly easy to gather: 2020-2021 & 2021-2022.

Britany Elsey:

- *Unified Solar Permit:* information prepared to send to trustees for their review and discussion at the next meeting.
- *LED Lights:* lights are probably cobra-head, and some are replaced already.
- *Partnerships with other entities (CSC):* Riverside partnership is recent; what to submit can be found at (<https://climatesmart.ny.gov/actions-certification/actions/#open/action/129>)
- After Britany left, remaining members recommended that she continue to look for approachable CSC Actions at: <https://climatesmart.ny.gov/actions-certification/actions/>

Tom Chapman:

- *Unified Solar Permit:* had a conversation with CEO Bryan Hallgren
- *Energy Code Enforcement Training:* Mike Brown of CEC confirmed that our CEO Bryan Hallgren is registered for the event.
- Intends to continue researching *PE6 Action: Smart Growth Policies* to see if any CSC points apply based on our Zoning Code

Scott Swimley:

- Offered to help compile benchmarking data, in the event Clerk Names would like assistance or the requirements end up being elaborate.

Vickie Button:

Hannah Waschezyn

- Presented findings from her comparison of the comprehensive plan with the requirements of the action point "Comprehensive Plan with Sustainability Elements"

concerns about the acceptance of the existing comprehensive plan as having the required elements, but it does seem worth submitting; she will continue to work to try to justify the required and bonus point elements for submission.

- Repair community (Tom Chapman brought Scott Swimley up to speed from last meeting)
- Climate Adaptation Plan (Hannah Waschezyn described an overview of what one would entail)

Questions and tasks for Chloe Thornton:

- What is the process to put the Unified Solar Permit into effect?
- Carried over from last month:
 - Intends to connect with Anne Names about energy benchmarking documentation; Michael Brown of Clean Energy Communities (CEC) noticed it was already completed.
 - Intends to review the specific Climate Smart Communities (CSC) Actions which the Village may already have completed, in order to find what exactly needs to be submitted in order to receive credit for them.
